

NORTHREACH PROJECT UPDATE #5– APRIL 2018



The NorthReach Project Team have not met for a few weeks as we awaited the response from the Borough of Poole Planning Department to our application. This has now been received and, as a result, the Group met with the architects and Councillor Mike Brooke this week. We reviewed the written feedback from the Planning and Conversation Officers and also discussed the outcome of the on-site meeting with the representatives of the Borough.

At this meeting, following a review of the options and views from all of the attendees, the consensus of opinion was that, in order to maximise the likelihood of planning approval, we should adjust our plans, in terms of layout and design, to take account of the concerns from the Planning Department. The architects will now work on a revised set of plans for submission to the Borough.

The new plans will be available for the congregation to view shortly and the Project Group will also take the revised plans to the PCC for review and approval prior to submission to the Borough.

Councillor Brooke has offered his services to support our planning application as it progresses through the approval process with the Borough.
